Kyloe (pronounced Kahy-loh) is inspired by the hardy breed of highland cattle, the Kyloe, known to survive in the bitter windswept highlands and islands of Scotland. Black Bull Kyloe shares much of its likeness with this great breed – robust and with outstanding pedigree.

Kyloe is blended using the finest malt and grain whisky, at a high ratio of malt to grain, and bottled at a hearty 50% abv, without the use of chill filtration, to offer a bold, authentic and powerful sensory experience.

Tasting Notes: Colour: Rich Gold

Nose: Rich, with toffee apple, pear, clementine, brown sugar, and toast-

ed oak.

Flavour: Hazelnuts, milk chocolate, malt, and raisins. Finish: Vanilla, cream and oak. Medium to long.

Comment: A real clean, vibrant and rich blend, Kyloe is exceptionally

drinkable and will leave you wanting more.

MATURED TWELVE YEARS IN OAK CASKS

True to its heritage and truly different to the norm, Black Bull 12 year old blended Scotch whisky is bottled at a higher strength and contains a higher malt whisky content than most of the blended Scotch whiskies available today. Using only the highest quality malt and grain whisky from select distilleries in Scotland, matured in the finest sherry and bourbon casks, Black Bull 12 year old is blended to a formula of 50% malt to 50% grain whisky, and bottled at 50% abv (100 US proof), for a full-on flavour experience which will rampage all over your senses. This robust but versatile blend can be served neat, with water, or as a component of cocktails.

Black Bull is draped in history. The blend can trace its origins back to 1864, when it was first produced by George Willsher & Co in Dundee, Scotland, and with the repeal of prohibition in the 1930's, Black Bull really came to prominence in markets around the world. Black Bull continues to be available in markets worldwide and is blended and bottled, with care, by the award winning Duncan Taylor Scotch Whisky Ltd.an

Tasting Notes:

Colour: Full Amber

Nose: Robust, chunky aromas. Chocolate, toffee, sherry, vanilla and lemon

sherbet.

Flavour: Smooth, mellow and rounded. Milk chocolate, treacle toffee, pears,

green apples and lots of sweet vanilla.

Finish: Some heavier fruity notes emerge, and lots of creamy notes coming

through.

Comment: A very creamy whisky with a lot fruity toffee notes.

Black Bull was first released to discerning drinkers in 1864, and has since grown to become a renowned whisky of quality, offering a powerful sensory experience, and delivering indulgent, uncompromised depth.

Black Bull is still blended to the same formula today as was used in the very beginning, using a large percentage of quality Speyside and Highland malts, matured in sherry and bourbon casks, blended to a high malt to grain ratio, and finally bottled at a robust 50% abv.

Black Bull is unfettered by chill filtration, allowing the character of each carefully selected whisky to shine through to its full potential, resulting in a unique blend that is outstanding in its field.

Tasting Notes:

Colour: Bright Gold.

Citrus, red apples, tangerines with a touch of caramel. Very lively and fresh with zesty notes – an excellent balance! Nutmeg and cloves with sweetness of vanilla and barley sugars emerging. Warming pepper, gentle nutty notes and toasted marshmallows to finish.























Black Bull 40, the flagship of the Black Bull family, is a superior blend of the finest Single Malt and Single Grain whiskies available from Scotland's premium distilleries. The spirit in this bottling of Black Bull 40 contains whiskies ranging from 40 to 51 years old, 86% of which are malt whiskies from distilleries such as Glenlivet, Macallan, Caperdonich, Highland Park and Bunnahabhain. Single grain whiskies make up the remainder of the blend, among them whiskies from Caledonian and Dumbarton distilleries.

This small batch production has been blended without the use of chill filtration or added colourant.

Completely natural, it is bottled at cask strength.

The rich, matte black bottle is contained in a deluxe, black glossy piano box style presentation box – an ideal gift for any whisky connoisseur!

Tasting Notes

Colour: Amber gold

Nose: Beautifully sweet, sherried, toffee apples, milk chocolate,

grapefruit, mango, parma violets and dried bananas

Taste: Very smooth and gentle with a vibrant fruitiness, then vanilla comes through, toffee popcorn, fruit cake and a hint of

hazelnuts

Finish: Long and lingering with a gentle syrupy sweetness
